- 1. Call to Order Kayt called the meeting to order at 6:12pm
- 2. Public Concerns: None
- 3. Correspondence:
 - 1. MASC email regarding budgeting and guidelines
- 4. Alex motioned to approve 3/5/25 minutes. 2nd- Jim. All in favor.
- 5. Principal's Report:
 - 1. Accolades and Happenings
 - 1. Spring Concert was a success; scheduled earlier than usual, but was timed well with regard to play, spring sports starting, etc.
 - 2. Save the Date(s) for "Beauty and the Beast" play: 1:00pm formal dress rehearsal on Friday 4/11. First formal showing 6pm Friday 4/11. Saturday 4/12 Matinee, 2pm.
 - 1. The school had grant money that was used for a sound system. Thank you to Mrs. G (music teacher) and a colleague of hers for their hard work in getting the sound system up and running.
 - 3. Grant funded swimming program in North Adams which has been a success with many families taking part in this.
 - 1. Samantha Lincoln increased her professional development by becoming a lifeguard which has been really helpful in many regards (Jiminy pool party, etc.).

2. Enrollment:

- 1. Consistent at 48; Projected at 43 for next year (4 6th graders graduating, 2 pre schoolers who are not eligible to continue, 1 incoming Hancock kindergartener)
- 2. No change to current status of School Choice; still many inquiries for school choice as well as out of district pre-K program.
- 3. School 2025-2026 Calendar
 - 1. Will vote at May meeting; draft can be disseminated.
- 4. Upcoming Events/Schedules
 - 1. ELA MCAS will begin before April break. Math MCAS prior to Memorial Day.
 - 2. HOPE Egg Hunt 4/13, 1pm
 - 3. April vacation 4/21-25
 - 4. 4 week, full day Summer Program led by Mrs. Dowling.
- 6. Superintendent's Report:
 - 1. Dr. Phillips wanted to share with us a meeting she had with Aldonna G (music teacher) where Mrs. G spoke of the "joy and sense of community that she experiences at Hancock."
 - 2. Home Run Bill
 - 1. There is a new house chair for Education Committee; hoping that hearings will begin to be scheduled within the next 2 weeks.
 - 3. Pre-School tuition contract for out of state/out of district students: Discussion and possible vote
 - 1. Last spring School Committee ended out of state/district enrollment for Pre-K students due to the financial implications of the Hancock School District assuming responsibility for any/all special education needs.
 - 2. Discussed an out of state/out of district tuition policy, similar to what is currently in place for K-6 where the applicant assumes financial responsibility for the per pupil tuition cost as well as 504/IEP services.

- 3. Rebecca is speaking with our legal counsel, Kim, regarding questions that have come up including and not limited to: 1) where the incoming tuition money will go (revolving account), 2) yearly re-evaluation of student placement.
- 4. More discussion and possible vote at May meeting.
- 4. Discussion about how to manage and move forward with Pre-K/K rooms given current enrollment with options for how to divide or combine these age groups and what that means for teacher placement.
- 5. Summer Academy is fully funded by the combination of Rural Aid and REAP grants.
 - 1. This funding has also been used for the Play, Sound System, and other activities that enrich the kids' overall lives in addition to their educational experience.
- 6. Miscellaneous
 - 1. Rebecca will speak with Andrew Court, superintendent in New Lebanon, to update tuition contract
 - 2. Accolades to our Honor Roll High School students (14 students total).
 - 3. Looking at overall results from both MCAS and Benchmark data in a side-by-side comparison.
 - 1. Discussion about MCAS formatting and test design
 - 2. Rebecca will parse out benchmark data specific to grades 3-6.

 - 1. FY26 3 year cycle for special ed and civil rights audit. Some of this will be onsite (no date yet).
