- 1. Call to Order Kayt called the meeting to order at 6:09pm
- 2. Public Concerns: None

- 4. Kayt motioned to approve 2/10/25 minutes. 2nd- Alex. All in favor.
- 5. Principal's Report:
 - 1. Accolades
 - 1. B&G Club field trip was a success.
 - 2. Ski Program at Jiminy went smoothly as well; very happy to have this offering in our community.
 - 2. Enrollment:
 - 1. Consistent at 48; 38 are Hancock residents
 - 2. Letters sent out to families of residents turning 3, 4 or 5 to get an idea of demographics for incoming students next year.
 - 3. No change to current status of School Choice; still many inquiries.

 - 1. Roof remains ok; no problems recently despite all the snow and ice. In the spring we'll need a roofer that is familiar with a rubber membrane roof.

 - 3. Sound system has been ordered for school play. Mrs. G (music teacher) had applied for a grant to upgrade stage lighting.

- 6. Superintendent's Report:
 - 1. Power School Data Breach:
 - 1. Our old Student Management Program had a data breach at the end of Dec 2024. We had a contract with them through March 1st despite us moving to a different platform. We did not use many of their offered programs, so the breach affected us very little. We had names and addressed that could have been breached, but we have not been informed that any families or teachers have been directly impacted. Power School knows the person who stole the data and the data has been returned (read: it is not on the dark web).
